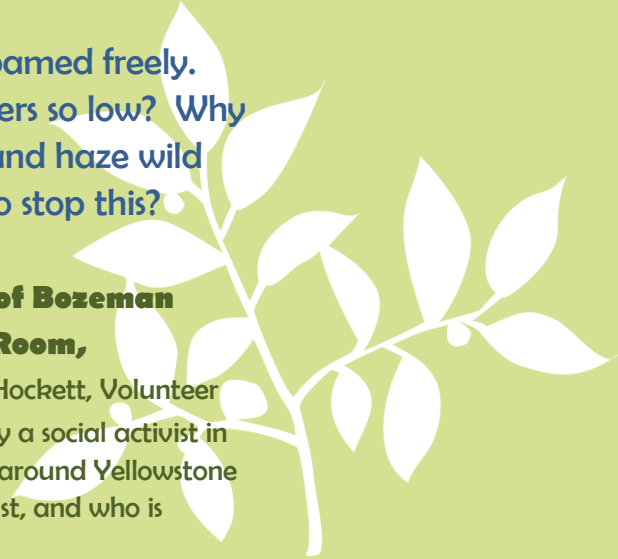


WHY do the **BUFFALO** cry:
